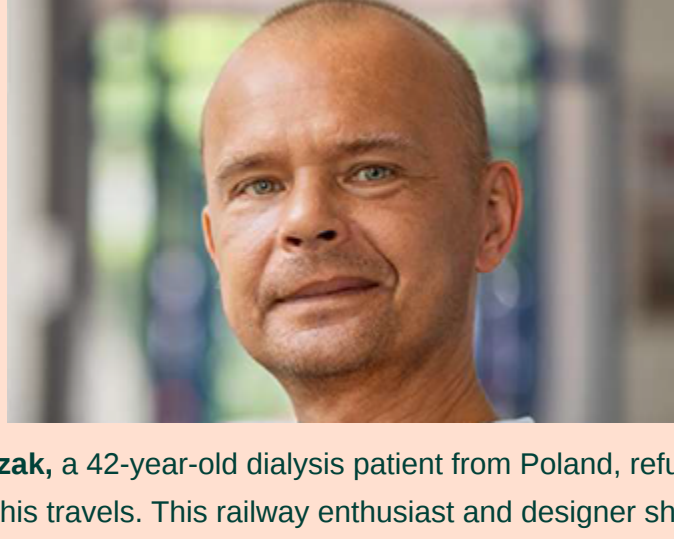

Cascais, Portugal

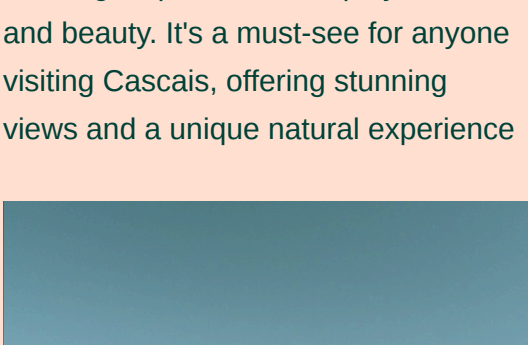
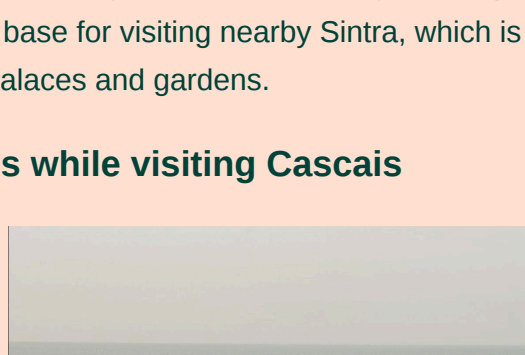
Uncover this magnificent coastal town where the Atlantic Ocean meets the charm of a historic coastal town.

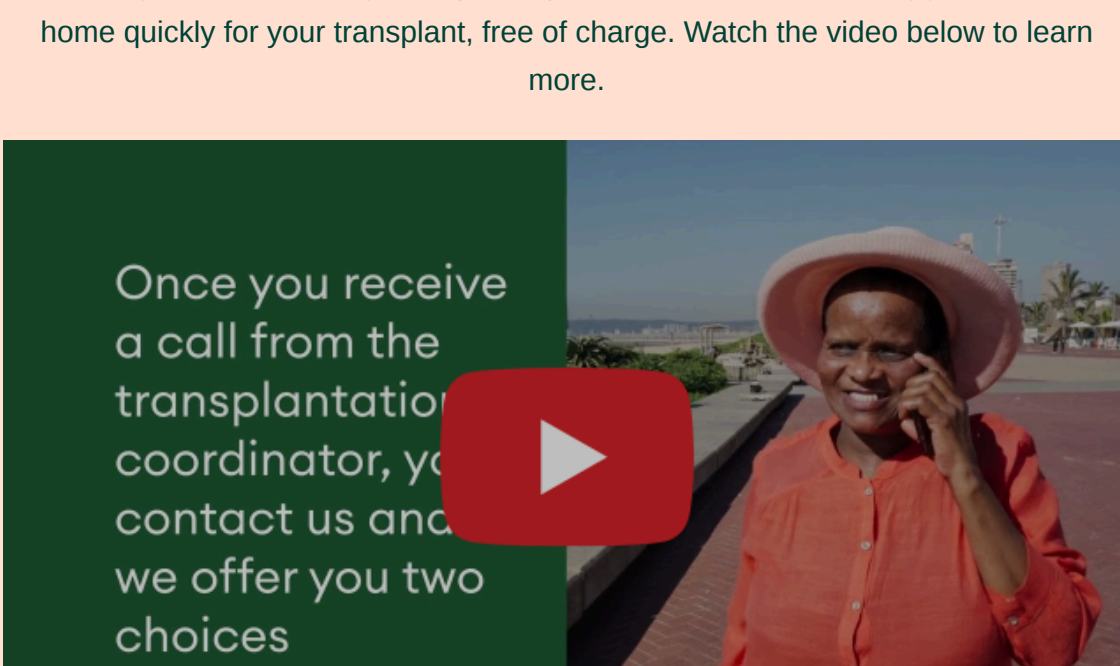
