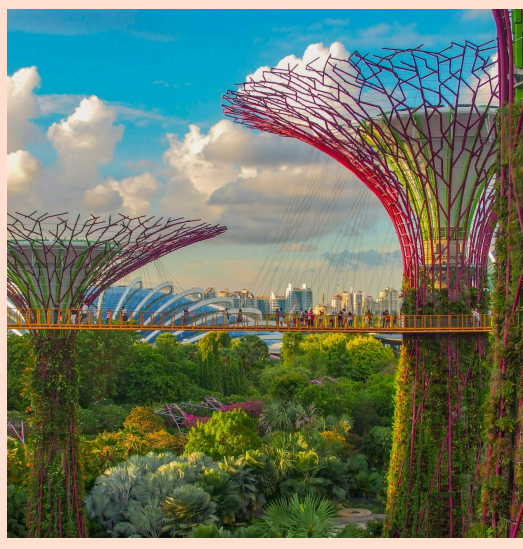
Singapore

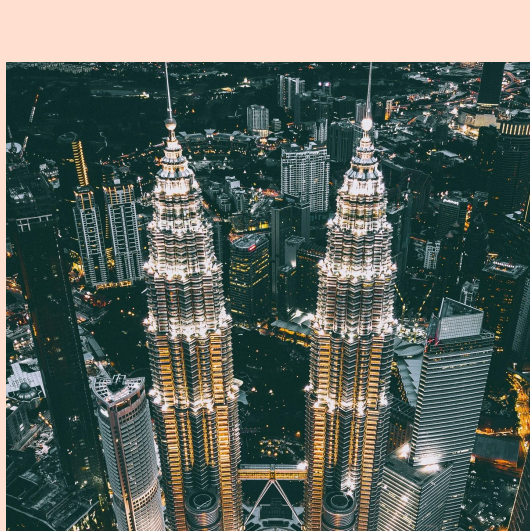
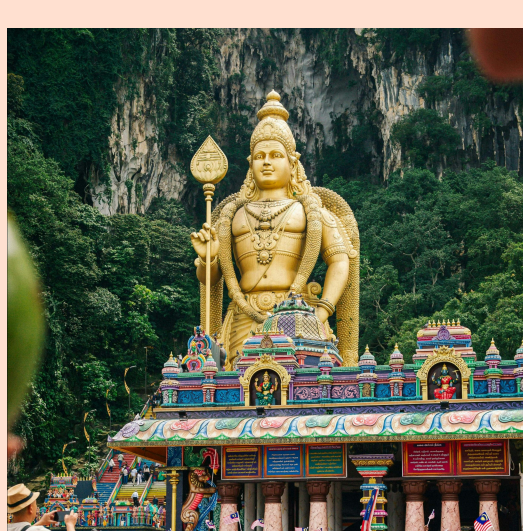
Malaysia
